Family Resource Programs (Fee for service)

Mini Camp (3 to 6 years on their own) Must be toilet trained.

Exciting programs designed for your 3 to 6 year old on their own to explore creative, sensory and science activities, while making social connections with other children. Each week will have a different project based theme. Registration is required.

Cost: \$50 per child per week

Kids Konnection (2 to 6 years on their own)

Need some time for you? Our special program offers parents and caregivers time for themselves while their children have fun with our qualified staff creating crafts, painting and singing songs. 8 week session allows you to register for certain days, or all 8. Registration is required.

Cost: \$17 per child / per morning

Busy Fingers, Busy Feet (ages 9 to 18 months)

Join us for 1 1/2 hours of fun and exploration through sensory and motor activities for children and their parents / caregivers. Registration is required.

Cost: \$40 for July 4 week session, \$30 for August 3 week session (due to August 1st holiday)

Messing Around (18 months to 24 months)

Introduce your toddler to a preschool-type experience with fun and engaging activities. Pick up a paint brush and dip into a rainbow of colours and a world of shapes. Discover different textures while gluing unique collages and stimulate their senses through exciting experiences. (Younger siblings not yet crawling may join). Registration is required.

Cost: \$40 per 4 week session



Family Math Time (3 to 5 years)

Led by an Early Literacy Consultant, this program invites parents and their children to come together to work, play, and develop positive attitudes towards mathematics. Families will enjoy games and activities that reinforce skills and develop math concepts such as: number sense, measurement, geometry patterning and data management. Participants will receive a math kit with fun interactive activities and a homework bag.

(Younger siblings not yet crawling welcome). Registration is required.

Cost: \$60 for 4 week session

Stroller Fit ((infants 8 weeks and up)

Meet up with other moms, network and exercise in the fresh air at the same time. The class is 1 hour in length and includes 3 stops along the way that are action packed with exercises to help get you fit! This class is taught by a Certified Fitness Instructor. Group leaves from White Oaks Plaza. Registration is required.

Cost: \$58 for 7 week session

Mom and Baby Zumba (8 weeks and up)

Need to exercise but want to party, AND have a baby? Come on out and dance with us knowing your baby is in a safe place - with you! Bring your baby and dance together to the rhythms of cumbia, salsa, belly-dancing and more! Mom, get your groove back in a fun, high-calorie burning Zumba party! This program is taught by a certified Zumba Instructor. Registration is required.

Cost: \$60 for 6 week session

Family Resource Program (FRP)– fee for service



Family Resource Programs are funded through a yearly grant from the United Way of Milton and program user fees.

Volunteer Action Plan- You must have your family volunteer number listed on the registration form in order to register for programs. Participants in the volunteer action plan will include families participating in MCRC's Family Resource Programs (mandatory) Ontario Early Years Centre (optional). Why? MCRC implemented our volunteer action plan in order to maintain programming levels with an ever increasing registration list and a growing community. Our funding has not increased and demands for programming have increased.

How it works... Each family fills out the contact information and will pay a \$25.00 deposit (to be renewed for programs beginning September 1st each year). Payment can be made by cheque, debit, credit card or cash. Your deposit will be available at reception three weeks after completing your volunteer time or you may choose to donate your \$25 in lieu of volunteer time.

Check the Volunteer Board located in the Lobby for Volunteer options and tasks. Tasks may include purchasing program materials or making resources. Each task is rated in time allotments towards your hours of volunteer time.

Calling New Parents

Calling New Parents is a weekly drop-in support group for parents with infants under 6 months of age. This program is offered by the Halton Regional Health Department and is supported by a Public Health Nurse who is available to answer questions. The group meets to talk about topics related to baby care and parenting. It is a great place to meet new friends! The program is free and you can join anytime! Note: Topics are subject to change.
